At registration for a Grower ID, growers will become members of GAP Connections and receive the following benefits:

- Grower ID card for scanning at GAP trainings for easy tracking of attendance
- Online access to their grower profile and GAP training history
- Easy way to share their GAP efforts with member companies
- Biannual GAP Connections electronic newsletter
- Voice in the U.S. Tobacco GAP standard setting process
- Access to training calendar and many online grower resources

If a grower does not have internet access, they will still be able to have their Grower ID card scanned at GAP trainings and be able to share their GAP information with member companies. An annual transcript of their GAP records will be mailed from GAP Connections.

Grower ID System

The Grower ID System is a secure database of tobacco growers involved in the U.S. Tobacco GAP Program. The system, by assigning a unique ID number to each grower, will help growers easily keep track of and share their GAP compliance records with potential companies. Instead of a grower's GAP efforts being tracked only through their current contracting companies, growers will have their GAP information follow them from year to year regardless of marketing company.

Step 1: Registering for Grower ID

Growers can register by going to the GAP Connections website at www.gapconnections.com. When growers register for a card they will be asked to provide the following information:

- First, Middle, and Last Name
- Email
- Phone Number
- Mailing address, City, State, Zip

- Farm Name
- Farm address,
 City, State, Zip
- County of primary farm operation
- Birthdate (MM/DD/YYYY)
- Type of tobacco, Acres of each

Step 2: Getting the Grower ID card

Once the online registration form is completed a Grower ID Number will be immediately assigned to the grower. A temporary or permanent Grower ID card can be obtained in a variety of ways

Option 1: Grower registers on a device that is connected to a printer. A temporary card is printed immediately that can be used at a training event until a permanent card can be obtained in the mail.

Option 2: Grower registers on a device without access to a printer.

A grower can use their Grower ID number and password they created when registering to navigate to their grower profile page and print a temporary card when they become connected to a printer. A permanent card will be mailed to you within 3 weeks.
