

Everyone **18+** is eligible for a **COVID-19 BOOSTER SHOT**

If you are 18 and older and have been fully vaccinated, you should get a COVID-19 booster shot to extend and strengthen your protection.

If you received a Moderna or Pfizer vaccine:

Get your booster 6 months after your second shot.

*Fully vaccinated people who received their first COVID-19 vaccines outside of the U.S. or in clinical trials with a brand not currently authorized can also receive a **Pfizer booster shot** when they are eligible.*

If you received a Johnson & Johnson vaccine:

Get your booster 2 months after your shot.

You can receive any brand of COVID-19 vaccine for your booster shot.

- Speak with a doctor, nurse or your local pharmacy if you have any questions about what booster is right for you.
- Booster shots are available anywhere COVID-19 vaccines are available, and you do not need a doctor's note to get a booster shot.
- You will need to know the dates and brand of your past COVID-19 vaccines.
- Paper vaccination cards are helpful but may not be necessary.
- At-home vaccination and free transportation may be available.
