GAPC Training Summary 2025



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IN-PERSON AND ONLINE ANNUAL GAPC TRAINING

2025 Annual GAP Training was completed on June 30, 2025. GAP Connections (GAPC) ended the year training **2,401** growers at either an in-person training location or through the online training platform available on the GAPC Grower Dashboard (See Table 1: Annual GAP Training Numbers by State and Event Type).

GAPC offers growers the opportunity to complete Annual GAP Training either by attending inperson training or online through the Grower Dashboard (See Table 2: In-Person versus Online Training). Most growers, 80%, attend in-person training and the remaining, 20%, use the online training platform.

In 2025, GAPC scheduled forty-five (45) training events including in-person, virtual, and makeup videos. GAPC planned and coordinated these training events with the assistance of State Extension Tobacco Specialists, County Extension Agents, and GAPC Company and Associate Members.

There were thirty-seven (37) training events scheduled with the State Extension Tobacco Specialists and County Extension Agents (County, Virtual, Makeup Video) and eight (8) training events scheduled in conjunction with GAPC Company Members meetings and events (Company) (See Table 3: 2025 Training by Event Type).

GAPC Staff with Dr. Bailey, Dr. Pearce, and Dr. Richmond offered virtual Annual GAP Training in April. Sixty-three (63) growers participated from twenty-two (22) counties in Kentucky, Tennessee, and Wisconsin. Growers pre-registered with their County Extension Office and attended training by watching the live streamed training for Burley and Dark Air & Fire Cured. The agents reported to GAPC the Grower's Name and GAPC Grower ID# for recording 2025 Annual GAP Training.

GAPC Staff worked with the State Extension Tobacco Specialists to prepare and record a makeup training video that could be used for growers that did not attend in-person training or cannot access online training. Make-up videos were made available for use in Virginia, Pennsylvania, and the Burley and Dark Air & Fire-cured regions. The makeup videos were released to County Extension Agents or used by a GAPC Member Company as a method for growers to complete Annual GAP Training. The Grower's Name and GAPC Grower ID# was reported to GAPC Staff and 2025 Annual GAP Training was recorded.

GAPC has been recording Annual GAP Training since 2014 and has a historical record of grower attendance. Annual GAP Training numbers were at their highest in 2015, with over 10,000 growers attending, but have declined 8-13% each year. Table 6 highlights Annual GAP Training numbers from the previous five years. The decline in attendance is due to many variables including retirements, changes in the farm operation and changes within the tobacco industry.

GAPC Staff worked with a variety of specialists to offer a wide variety of course topics for the online training option. A grower completing Annual GAP Training Online was required to complete 3 courses in Crop and Environmental Best Management Practices, 3 courses in Labor Best Management Practices, and 3 courses in GAPC Overview. Each course video ended with a knowledge assessment (quiz). For course credit to be earned the grower was required to score 100% on the quiz.

Course contributions for the Crop and Environmental Best Management Practices category were provided by Extension Tobacco Specialists (See Table 7: Crop and Environmental Best Management Practices – Online Courses Offered). There were 27 Crop and Environmental Courses for Tobacco and 5 Crop and Environmental Courses for Hemp offered in 2025. Courses listed in the table and bolded are new courses added in 2025.




Questions 1: What Management Topic during GAPC Annual Training did you find the most beneficial?


Question 2: Where do you get information to improve compliance in crop, environment, or labor management on your farm? (Select all that apply).




