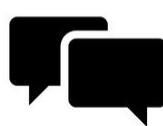

Farm Labor Contractors (FLC's) and H-2A Labor Contractors (H-2ALCs) have an important role in ensuring the health and well-being of the agriculture workforce, through promoting worker health and safety, fair labor practices and worker rights. However, FLC's often have limited opportunities to participate in trainings to learn the laws and regulations surrounding their roles.
