Audits, Site Visits and Assessments have begun in flue-cured growing regions...

Monitoring visits are beginning this week in flue-cured regions for those growers who are going through the GAPC Certification Program or those who were selected for an assessment by their company. Auditing firms should be contacting you directly to schedule the monitoring visit as they move through the growing regions. If you are in the GAPC Certification Program please contact your chosen firm directly with questions about scheduling and invoicing.

What is the difference between assessments and Certification Audits?

There are three major differences between assessments and Certification Audits; (1) who pays, (2) how are growers selected, and (3) how results are interpreted.

Assessments:

- Paid for by the company(s)
- Growers randomly selected and/or selected according to company instructions
- Results are interpreted and evaluated by the company(s)

Certification Audit or Site Visit:

- Paid for by the grower
- Growers elect to participate in a Certification Audit to fulfill the requirement of the GAPC Certification Program
- Results are scored and evaluated by GAPC

2019 Self-Assessment

The self-assessment is available now at www.gapconnections.com. To complete, log into your profile via our website at www.gapconnections.com. On your Grower Dashboard go to "Self-Assessment" > "Grower Self-Assessment".

Reminders:

- Growers going through the GAPC Certification program are required to complete the Self-Assessment before the audit/site visit. It is one Self-Assessment per operation.
- The Self-Assessment will auto save after every 10 minutes. If the screen goes blank, don't panic, it's just saving.
- After a question is answered the box will turn blue. Any grey boxes are the ones you will need to answer.
- The percentages will update at the top of the page each time you submit your answers. Depending on the speed of your internet the new percentages could take 5 seconds to 15 seconds to update.

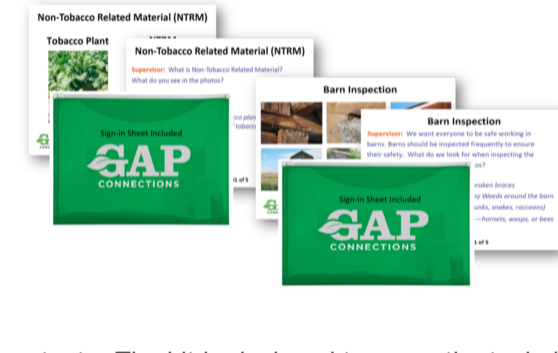
2019 Poster Requirements

If your farm has at least one worker who is not immediate family labor (including those enrolled in vocational or apprenticeship program) who helps produce the tobacco crop the following posters must be visible to all workers:

- Worker Concern Helpline poster (NEW 2019 poster required)
- All in One Labor Standards Poster (NEW 2019 poster required)
- The Workers Rights and Responsibilities poster

If your farm has ONLY immediate family labor, posters are not required.

Remember, proper documentation is required of the Worker Concern Helpline poster which can be found in the record packet. For a copy of the Worker Concern Helpline Documentation click [here](#).

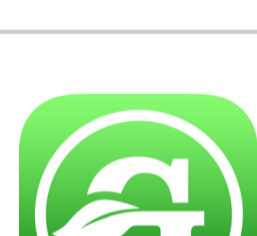


Emergency Preparedness Resources

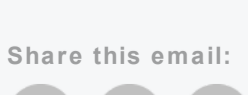
