GAP Connections Assessments This year we have three firms conducting the GAP

Connections Assessments, ARCHE Advisors, UL Responsible Sourcing, and Context Network LLC. The auditors have begun scheduling the assessments so if you were chosen, you should be getting a call soon depending on your tobacco type. These three firms have started conducting assessments in the flue cured region, and they will begin assessments in the burley and dark regions in late July. Assessments are expected to last into October. Letters were mailed out to every grower who was chosen for a GAP Connections assessment. What is the difference between assessments and Certification Audits?

There are three major differences between assessments and Certification Audits; (1) who pays, (2) how are growers selected, and (3) how results are interpreted.

Growers elect to participate in a Certification Audit to fulfill the requirement of the GAPC

Assessments:

Paid for by the company(s) · Growers randomly selected and/or selected according to company instructions

Results are interpreted and evaluated by the company(s)

· Paid for by the grower
