## GAP Connections would like to congratulate the 223 operations that have successfully achieved GAPC Certification in 2022.

Monitoring Visits are still occurring and will conclude by late October. Reminders for those participating in the Certification Program:

- 1. Assigned auditors will be reaching out to growers 10-14 days prior to schedule a date and time for the monitoring visit. It is important to check your phone, voicemails, emails and texts during this time to make sure the auditor can reach you.
- 2. The Self-Assessment is required for all operations. This should be completed before the auditor arrives to the farm.
- 3. Growers should receive an audit report either by email or mail with 72 hours of your monitoring visit (depending on the method of preferred correspondence you included on your application). It is important to review this report in a timely manner to determine if any remediation is needed to pass. If you did not receive this report, please contact the GAPC office at (865) 622-4606 or email info@gapconnections.com.
- 4. Remediation must be done within 30 days of the audit report being submitted to GAPC. Instructions on how to remediate any remediable issue can be found in the <a href="Remediation Guide">Remediation Guide</a> and in the <a href="GAPC">GAPC</a> Certification Compliance Guide.
- 5. Growers who have achieved Certification will receive a letter and a certificate by mail or email (depending on the preferred method of correspondence). Growers may also access the Certification Status report via the GAPC Grower System. Log in <a href="here">here</a>, find Certification, then find Certification Status on the Grower Dashboard.
- 6. After the Monitoring Visit, you will receive a short survey requesting feedback on the visit. We ask you to please participate in this survey to help us better the program. Growers will also be asked if you'd like a Certificate Gate Sign in the event the operation becomes GAPC Certified.
- 7. Tips for achieving Certification are emailed every week. Check your inbox or click here to view past
- 8. The application period for 2023 will begin in January. Participants much submit an application annually in order to maintain Certification.

## Not heard from your Monitoring Firm and your visit requires worker interviews? Reach out!

Keep in mind that operations participating in a Year 1 Full Audit and have hired labor require worker interviews. Operations who have indirect hired labor (FLC or H2ALC) are required to have worker interviews annually. It is important that workers are there the day of the audit for worker interviews to take place. If you haven't heard from the Monitoring Firm please contact them.
